9 Programs – 1 Mission

Here's what you're helping to accomplish in San Diego...

NUEVA VIDA HAVEN: newly remodeled emergency overnight shelter for women and children. San Diego Rescue Mission is the only emergency shelter open all night for battered and abused women and children.

WOMEN AND CHILDREN'S CENTER: a 12-month residential recovery program for women and women with children.

MEN'S CENTER: a state licensed 12-month residential recovery program for men.

OUTPATIENT THERAPY CLINIC: free counseling for homeless, addicted and abused men, women and children.

RECUPERATIVE CARE UNIT: a safe place for homeless men and women who require follow-up care after hospital emergencies.

PARTNERS FOR HUNGER RELIEF: the Rescue Mission collects thousands of pounds of food each week from over 100 partners that would otherwise be thrown away: 3 million pounds annually. We use the food at the Rescue Mission, as well as for the poor in our community, by supporting more than 40 smaller non-profit organizations.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING: a multi-phase transitional housing program designed for women, women with children and men who are working toward maintaining self-sufficiency.

CHILDREN'S CENTER: San Diego Rescue Mission's state licensed preschool is a program designed for the children of participants in Nueva Vida Haven, the Women and Children's Center & Transitional Housing.

THRIFT STORES: the Rescue Mission currently operates four thrift stores in economically disadvantaged neighborhoods in San Diego County. These stores provide a low-cost alternative to their neighbors, work experience for our clients and revenue to the Rescue Mission.
